



Quest 6 Dress Code

We expect Sixth Form students to dress in a smart casual manner that reflects maturity and readiness for learning, while allowing some personal expression. Your appearance should be appropriate for a working environment.

What you CAN wear:

- **Tops:** Polo shirts, blouses, smart jumpers, cardigans, or shirts.
- **Bottoms:** Smart trousers, chinos, tailored skirts or dresses of appropriate length.
- **Footwear:** Trainers, shoes, boots – **must be plain black, brown or plain white** only.
- **Outerwear:** Smart jackets, coats, or blazers.

The following items are not permitted:

- Ripped or baggy jeans.
- Denim of any kind.
- Joggers or sweatpants.
- Hoodies (including zip-up styles).
- Clothing with large logos, graphics, or slogans.
- Shorts (unless tailored and approved during summer months).
- Flip-flops, Crocs or brightly coloured shoes/trainers.
- Sportswear.
- Leggings.
- Vest tops.
- High top trainers

Additional Notes:

- Hats, caps, or hoods must not be worn indoors.
- Clothing must not be revealing or expose midriffs.
- This list is not exhaustive. Please speak to the Head of Sixth Form if in doubt.
